***WED - THUR – Pre-Shoot Clinics:** Call Becky to register—first come basis. **John Shima** - 1/2 day or full day clinics on both days. **Terry Hetrick** - clinics on Thursday.*

THURSDAY — Registration opens at noon at the Vince Marcum Pavilion. Practice will be available from 10am to 7pm. Pay at Registration Desk/Cashier.

FRIDAY – ALL DAY: Novice/Team Event. Entry fee: \$60 (includes coaching, targets, lunch, and award(s)). Deposit is \$25.

9:00 - Noon: Novice instruction in small groups for ladies who are beginners with a shotgun or those who have never shot registered clay targets.

1:00 - 3:00pm: Team event of 50 birds. Scores compiled individually and by teams including coach's score! Merchandise awards to winning team and medals to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place team members. Special trophy to novice champ.

1:00 - 5:00pm: NSSA Registered Doubles • 100 Birds • \$50 entry fee includes targets and fees. Trophies to CH/RU/3rd; medals to Class 1, 2 and 3.

FRIDAY NIGHT—Awards ceremony for the Novice and Doubles Events. Refreshments served during shoot-off and awards ceremony at the Marcum Pavilion.

SATURDAY – DAY 1 of 400 Bird Registered Championship. \$200 four-gun entry includes targets, fees and dinner Saturday. \$50 deposit required. Trophies and medals to CH, RU, 3rd, and Class 1, 2 and 3 in all four guns, plus HOA. Special event for lady shooters at their first registered shoot—12 ga. only. Awards to 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

Special non-registered .410 Men's Event: \$50 entry fee for volunteer shoot workers and guests (i.e. any male who wants to shoot and donate to the cause!) 50 regular skeet, 50 doubles—may be shot on Friday or Saturday. Sign up at the Registration Desk by noon Saturday. Awards to CH/RU/3rd (and maybe more!).

***Pistol Competition:** \$20 entry fee; open to all ladies and gentlemen. Shoot on Saturday or Sunday. Sign-up by noon Saturday at the Registration Desk. Awards TBD. Sponsored by Smith & Wesson.*

Raffle Tables: Get your "little table items" \$3 (4 four \$10, 10 for \$20) and "big table items" \$10 (3 for \$25) raffle tickets distributed amount the items of your choice by 4:30 (start of last flight) Saturday! **Buy them at Registration Desk/Cashier starting at noon Thursday.**
